EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE CITY OF WEST FORK, ARKANSAS CITY COUNCIL HELD NOVEMBER 14, 2016

The City Council of the City of West Fork, Arkansas (the "City") met in special session at 6:30 p.m., on the 14th day of November, 2016. The Mayor put the question on the adoption of the motion and the roll being called, the following voted aye: Anita Lowry, Jeff Upton, Kira Hungate, Misty Caudle, Joe Toher. and the following voted nay:

Thereupon the Mayor declared that at least two-thirds of all members of the Council having voted in favor of the motion to suspend the rule, the motion was carried and the rule suspended. The Ordinance was then read by title only.

Alderman <u>Misty Caudle</u>, seconded by Alderman <u>Kira Hungate</u>, moved that the rule requiring the reading of an ordinance in full on three different days be further suspended and that the Ordinance be placed on its second reading by title only. The Mayor put the question on the adoption of the motion and the roll being called, the following voted aye: <u>Anita Lowry, Jeff Upton, Kira Hungate, Mike Nelson, John Collins, Ed Stout, Misty Caudle, Joe Toher.</u> and the following voted nay:

Thereupon the Mayor declared that at least two-thirds of all members of the Council having voted in favor of the motion to suspend the rule, the motion was carried and the rule suspended. The Ordinance was then read by title only.

Thereupon the Mayor declared that at least two-thirds of all members of the Council having voted in favor of the motion to suspend the rule, the motion was carried and the rule suspended. The Ordinance was then read by title only.

Alderman Misty Caudle, seconded by Alderman Kira Hungate moved that the
Ordinance be adopted. The question was put by the Mayor on the adoption of the
motion and the roll being called, the following voted aye: Anita Lowry, Jeff Upton, Kira
Hungate, Mike Nelson, John Collins, Ed Stout, Misty Caudle, Joe Toher.
and the following voted nay:

Alderman Misty Caudle, seconded by Alderman <u>Kira Hungate</u> moved that Section 10, the emergency clause, be adopted and on roll call, the following voted aye: <u>Anita Lowry, Jeff Upton, Kira Hungate, Mike Nelson, John Collins, Ed Stout, Misty Caudle, Joe Toher.</u>

and the following voted nay:____

The Mayor thereupon declared the Ordinance and the emergency clause adopted and signed the Ordinance, which was attested by the City Clerk and sealed with the seal of the City. The Ordinance was given $\underline{No.462}$

After a discussion by the Mayor and the Council, it was decided that the Ordinance and all other ordinances of the City relating to the promissory note, should be posted in the following public places in the City:

Bank of Fayetteville West Fork Branch
Arvest Bank West Fork Branch
West Fork City Hall
West Fork Post Office

There being no further business, the Council adjourned.
